- Monitoring, maintaining and continually improving safety performance by setting clear achievable targets and objectives with a periodic review.
- Ensuring all accidents, incidents and near misses are reported and investigated.
- Preventing pollution and minimising waste through effective training and procedures.
- Assessing and reducing social and environmental impacts.

- Establishing effective dialogue with customers on all aspects of the performance of our service.

Operatives and Craftsperson

Have a responsibility to report unsafe conditions to their supervisor and:

- Work in a safe manner.
- Challenge those that are not working safely.
- Use equipment provided for safety correctly.
- Take responsibility for personal safety.
